Commissioner Magwood's Comments on SECY-11-0049, "Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes Reporting Structure: Options, Analysis, and Proposed Implementation Plans"

I appreciate the work of the staff and the ACMUI to engage in an open discussion and analysis of the reporting structure for this important advisory committee. The Commission relies very heavily on ACMUI's expertise to inform its consideration of issues associated with the agency's oversight of radioactive materials used in medical applications. It is vital that we assure that ACMUI can fulfill this role in the most efficacious manner.

The analysis reflected in SECY-11-0049 provides a good review of the issues at play and I approve the staff's recommendation. As described by the SECY paper, the staff will continue its work with ACMUI in accordance with FSME Policy and Procedure 2-5 for major medical policy issues, including rulemaking, and staff will provide ACMUI recommendations—along with the staff's evaluation of the recommendations—to the Commission. I believe this approach addressed the concerns reflected in SRM-M100708B.

Further, I fully support ACMUI's intent to reevaluate the structure on a regular basis. If over time, ACMUI finds that changes are required to the structure, staff should notify the Commission. I also understand the ACMUI's concerns regarding the resources it believes are required to support its activities. I encourage the staff to give fully consideration to these concerns. It is appropriate, as staff has indicated, to review the ACMUI's recommendation to increase resources in the context of the FY 2013 budget proposal to the Commission. The results of this review should be provided to the Commission as it considers the agency's FY 2013 budget request.
