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Office of Administration (ADM) Items of Interest Week Ending October 14, 2011

<u>Design-Basis Hurricane and Hurricane Missiles for Nuclear Power Plants; Regulatory Guide</u> (RG); Issuance, 10 CFR Parts 50 and 52 (NRC-2010-0288)

On October 13, 2011, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (76 FR 63541) announcing the issuance of a new regulatory guide, RG 1.221, "Design-Basis Hurricane and Hurricane Missiles for Nuclear Power Plants." This RG provides licensees and applicants with new guidance acceptable by the NRC for use in selecting the design-basis hurricane and hurricane-generated missiles that a nuclear power plant should be designed to withstand to prevent undue risk to the health and safety of the public.

Event Reporting Guidelines; Draft NUREG; Request for Comment; 10 CFR Part 50 (NRC-2011-0237)

On October 13, 2011, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (76 FR 63565) requesting comments on Draft NUREG-1022, Revision 3, "Event Reporting Guidelines: 10 CFR 50.72 and 50.73." The NUREG contains guidelines that the NRC staff considers acceptable for use in meeting the event reporting requirements for operating nuclear power reactors. Revision 3 to NUREG-1022 incorporates revisions to the guidelines for the purpose of clarification. Comments are requested by December 12, 2011.

Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) Items of Interest Week Ending October 14, 2011

RES Publication of Regulatory Guide (RG) 1.221, "Design-Basis Hurricane and Hurricane Missiles for Nuclear Power Plants"

On October 13, 2011, staff published RG 1.221. This guide describes a method that the staff considers acceptable for selecting the design-basis hurricane wind speed and hurricane-generated missiles that a new nuclear power plant should be designed to withstand to prevent undue risk to public health and safety. This supports reviews of applications that the agency expects to receive for new nuclear reactor construction permits or operating licenses under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR), Part 50, "Domestic Licensing of Production and Utilization Facilities" (10 CFR Part 50); design certifications under 10 CFR Part 52, "Licenses, Certifications, and Approvals for Nuclear Power Plants;" and combined licenses under 10 CFR Part 52 that do not reference a standard design.
