I. <u>SECY-11-0026 – Southern Nuclear Operating Co. (Vogtle Electric Generating Plant, Units 3 and 4) – Appeal of LBP-10-21</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to an appeal by the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League, Georgia Women's Action for New Directions, and the Center for a Sustainable Coast of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision in LBP-10-21 denying their motion to reopen this combined license proceeding. The Memorandum and Order affirms the Board's decision.

II. <u>SECY-11-0099 - Luminant Generation Company LLC (Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant, Units 3 & 4), Intervenors' Petition for Review (Mar. 11, 2011)</u>

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a petition for review by the Sustainable Energy and Economic Development Coalition, Public Citizen, True Cost of Nukes, and Texas State Representative Lon Burnam of an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board decision in the Comanche Peak combined license proceeding. The Memorandum and Order denies the petition for review and affirms the Board's decision in LBP-10-5. The applicant is directed to review the non-public version of this decision and, within seven days, advise whether the decision may be fully released to the public. Commissioner Magwood did not participate in this matter.

## III. <u>SECY-11-0116 – Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (Levy County Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2), Staff Petition for Review of LBP-10-20</u>
