The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to an appeal by the Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League, Georgia Women's Action for New Directions, and the Center for a Sustainable Coast of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision in LBP-10-21 denying their motion to reopen this combined license proceeding. The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order, which affirms the Board's decision. Would you please affirm your votes?

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order which denies the petition for review and affirms the Board's decision in LBP-10-5. The applicant is directed to review the non-public version of this decision and, within seven days, advise whether the decision may be fully released to the public. Commissioner Magwood did not participate in this

matter. Would Chairman Jaczko, Commissioner Svinicki, Commissioner Apostolakis and Commissioner Ostendorff, please affirm your votes?
